- Mother works as a psychologist with people in hospital
- My father is an engineer working in the nuclear fusion industry

- Germany is in the centre of Europe, 900 kilometres long and 600 wide, a lot more people than Australia with 83 mil-lion
- In Germany people wear socks with sandals, we ride a lot of bikes; there are extra bike lanes in the city as many people use bikes.
- We have no speed limit on our freeways and many drive at 200km per hour
- My city is in north east of the country

- After the fall of the Berlin Wall, many service clubs were created; we have 96 Clubs with about 4000 members
