Guest Speaker: Caitlin Holt -RYPEN

The Rotary Youth Program of Enrichment (RYPEN) is a weekend residential experience for youth aged 14-16 designed to develop skills that will assist them in the transition to adulthood.

Caitlin is a Senior Scout who wanted to fulfil the requirement to attend a personal development or leadership course which she needed for her Australian Scout Medallion which is the highest award a scout her age can achieve.

Her mother Alison had no hesitation in allowing her to go to a Rotary camp as she is a past Rotary Youth Exchange Student so knows well the competence of Rotary.

Caitlin was one of the youngest participants at the Woodhouse camp but soon

lost her nervousness and joined in enthusiastically after a few ice -breaker games.

Over the next three nights and four days they did many teamwork and leadership sessions too teach the value of and how to be a good team member.

Night hikes and an obstacle course necessitated working as a team and using other people's skills.

Further sessions with professionals, other experts and the camp leaders cemented this learning.

Caitlin believes that she will be able to combine these new skills with her old attributes to improve her performance in her future career as well as currently at school.

She now feels she has the skills to be a team player and to lead without being domineering and can also pass these attributes on to her friends and fellow scouting members.

Caitlin concluded by thanking the Rotarians who ran the camp, the team leaders there and the Rotary Club of Gawler Light for sponsoring her.
