Guest Speaker: : Lance Hatcher autobiography

- Ancestors came to Australia in 1850 and took 3 months to get here
- Farmed between Angle Vale and Virginia
- Parents married in 1936 and farmed in the Murray Mallee
- Employed ploughing sand off railway line
- Born 1937 in very hot December
- Grew up in Loxton; no electricity, mains water etc
- Kept cool in baby bath and cellar
- Moved to Gawler area and father worked for Dawkins family on their Dorsett Stud farm.
- Went to one teacher school at Gawler River –about15 or 16 students in the whole school
- Attended Gawler High School which was huge in comparison
- Went to high school in school bus
- Wanted to do book keeping beven though this was seen as a course for girls.
- Group of boys also expressed interest to do book keeping.
- Fond memories of book keeping teacher
- Got job in clothing factory where Steinborners is now; did book keeping
- 300 400 garments per day made
- Organised and distributed payroll
- Received scholarship to learn accounting
- Studied "Monetary Practice"
- Called up for National Service when 18 years old which was a valuable character building and learning experience
- Met his future wife in class in 1952; great square dancing partner

- At the end of 1954 left clothing factory and got job at Mudla Wirra Council where he was given 4 years training
- Needed certificates to work for local government
- By 1957 had all certificates needed to be district clerk and stayed there 4 years
- Moved to position in Munno Para Council, Murray St.
- Interesting logistics management in rapidly growing demographic
- Became representative for AMP
- After 2 years set up own
- July 1962 joined Gawler Rotary Club and has had 100% attendance ever since
- Travelled to England, Canada and Europe
- In 1985 helped Steve McLachlan to set up his painting business
- Enjoys working with numbers and getting it right
- Awarded Life Membership of Institute of Public Accountants
